# How to reach

#### Entry to Nepal can be made by air or road

- Travel by Air Tribhuvan International Airport is the only gateway to Kathmandu for the tourists who come by air. The Airport, named after King Tribhuvan, the 8th Shah King of Nepal, is about 4.5 miles east of the city. It is well connected to almost all the major destinations of the world and all major carriers, including Nepal Airlines, Air India, Indigo, SpiceJet, Qatar Airways, Turkish Airlines, Flydubai, Biman Bangladesh Airlines, Thai Airways, Etihad Airways, Oman Air, SilkAir flight, Malindo airlines and many more fly to Nepal. Within Nepal, most of the country is connected through the air through small aircraft flying on smaller runways.
- o **Travel by Road** While traveling by road, you can enter Nepal from the following border points:
  - Kakarbhitta (Eastern Nepal) with Panitanki on the Indian side in the state of West Bengal. Kakarbhitta is a small town on the border between Nepal and India which is about 15 17 hours (610 km) away from Kathmandu and about an hour drive from Siliguri. The closest airport is at Bhadrapur, about 25 km from there. The flight from Bhadrapur takes about 45 mins to land in Kathmandu.
  - Biratnagar with Jogbani on the Indian side in the state of Bihar. Biratnagar lies 399 km away from Kathmandu and 6 km from Indian Border. The Airport at Biratnagar has frequent flights to Kathmandu and other Nepal airports. It takes about 35 Mins to reach Kathmandu from Biratnagar by flight. Indian rail lines end at Jogbani, which has direct trains to Katihar, Kolkata, and New Delhi.
  - Birgunj (Central Nepal) with Raxaul on the Indian side in the state of Bihar. For Indian tourists, Birgunj, known as the "Gateway to Nepal," is the main entry point to Nepal by land, especially from Kolkata and Patna. It is about 210 km from Kathmandu and is connected to Raxaul by rail. Raxaul station & Sugauli station (17 miles from Raxaul) is well connected by train to major cities in India. Simara, about 20 km from Birgunj, is the nearest airport and takes about 20 minutes to reach Kathmandu by air.
  - Bhairahawa (Western Nepal) with Sunali on the Indian Side in the state of Uttar Pradesh Bhairahawa, also known as Siddharthanagar, is about 9 hours drive and 280 km from Kathmandu. It is the gateway to Lumbini, the birthplace of Lord Buddha. It takes about 30 minutes to reach Kathmandu from Bhairahawa by flight.
  - Nepalgunj (Western Nepal) with Rupaidiha on the Indian Side in Uttar Pradesh. Nepalgunj is about 13 hours drive and 530 km away from Kathmandu and is connected by direct flights to Kathmandu.
  - Dhangadhi (Western Nepal) with Gauriphanta on the Indian Side in Uttar Pradesh. Dhanghadi is about 660 km away from Kathmandu. It is mainly used by people of Delhi, which takes about 6 hours to travel to Nepal.
  - Mahendranagar (Western Nepal) with Banbasa on the Indian Side in Uttarakhand Mahendranagar is a small town about an 18-19 hours drive and 695 km from Kathmandu.





# **Best time to Travel**

The two best seasons to travel to Nepal would be spring and autumn. However, nowadays, it is seen that even summers/monsoon and winters have their charms and have started to see an inflow of tourists.

- Spring (March, April, and May) Spring probably is one of the most popular times to travel to Nepal. This period
  is characterized by pleasant temperature and is marked by the period when the flowers are in full bloom. The
  most important festival during this period is Holi.
- o **Autumn** (September, October & November) Autumn is a popular time to travel, especially for trekking and hiking. Clear views and pleasant temperatures characterize this period. The most important festival during this period is Dashain and Tihar.
- Summer (June, July & August) Considered an offseason period in Nepal. Sapphire Skies characterize this
  period, Lush Green valleys, beautiful landscapes, and less crowded. The most important festival during this
  period is Gai Jatra.
- Winter (December, January, and February) is considered an offseason period in Nepal. This is the best time to avoid the crowd as the skies are clear with great views of mountains. The most important festival during this period is Maha Shivaratri.

# **Entry Formalities for Indian Nationals:**

Indian Nationals – Indian nationals do not require any visa for Nepal. A permit will be issued at the entry point on the production of a passport (**with a minimum validity** of 6 months from the date of departure) or Voter ID (the only valid document for issuing the Nepal Entry permit). The traveler should also carry a copy of the travel documents and 04 passport-sized photographs. An original Birth certificate in English and student ID are required for children. ADHAR CARD/ PAN CARD / DRIVING LICENSE IS NOT A VALID DOCUMENT TO TRAVEL NEPAL BY AIR.

- The vehicle will not be at its disposal but will perform its respective duties as per the itinerary only. Half-Day sightseeing is for 3 hours. Full-day sightseeing is for 6 hours. E.g., Pashupatinath & Boudhanath constitutes a Half-Day Trip.
- Chitwan, being a jungle and remote area, the jungle activities and transfers vehicles are provided by hotels/lodges or resorts, which may be on SIC Basis and different than above. They may not also have air condition facilities.
- ❖ In our standard packages, we have considered vehicles based on maximum capacity. For instance, for 2 Pax traveling together, we have taken cars like Ford / Fiat / Manza / Swift Dezire; for 4 Pax & 6 Pax, we have considered Scorpio / Similar vehicles, and for 8 Pax and above till 12 pax, we have taken Toyota Hiace.
- ❖ In case of an increase in the number of heads, including children above the maximum capacity of vehicles considered, the guests will have to take the bigger vehicle for which supplement costs shall apply as mentioned above. For example, the capacity of car-like Ford / Fiat / Manza / Swift Dezire is 3 Pax, so if a group size consists of 4 pax, then the guests would have to pay a supplement for using Scorpio instead of SUV as mentioned above

## **Documentation - Permit Requirement**

Indian nationals do not require any visa for Nepal. A permit will be issued at the entry point on the production of a passport (with a minimum validity of 6 months from the date of departure) or Voter ID (the only valid document for issuing the Nepal Entry permit). The traveler should also carry a copy of the travel documents and 04 passport-sized photographs. An original Birth certificate in English and student ID are required for children. ADHAR CARD/PAN CARD / DRIVING LICENSE IS NOT A VALID DOCUMENT TO TRAVEL NEPAL BY AIR.

# **About Hotels**

- Many Nagarkot, Pokhara & Chitwan hotels do not have a lift. If you have any health-related issues you cannot climb higher floors, please inform us immediately at the time of confirmation so that we can take necessary actions.
- ❖ Most of the rooms in all hotels in Nepal are twin-bedded rooms. Minimal rooms have a king-size bed. King size bedded rooms will be provided subject to availability only. If the same is unavailable, we shall provide twin-bedded rooms only.
- Categories of Rooms in the packages are based on the base category of rooms, unless specified.
- Most hotels in other cities do not match the standards of hotels in Kathmandu & Pokhara. Please do not expect luxury facilities while traveling to other areas. If the guests cannot compromise on comfort, then such travel places should not be a part of the itinerary.
- The standard check-in time at Hotel is 1400 Hrs & Check-out time is 1100 Hrs. All requests for early check-in / late checkout / extending of stay will be solely at the hotel's discretion and shall be subject to room availability. A valid photo ID proof for all guests staying at the hotel is mandatory.
- For Extra Person Sharing the Room & Child with Extra Bed, almost all the hotels provide MATTRESS and ROLL AWAY BEDS as a supplement to Extra Bed.
- ❖ In the case of group or incentive travels, all the rooms provided may not be of the same size and category.
- ❖ In the hills, scarcity of water & power-cut is a natural phenomenon. In case of power-cut, the hotels provide power backup to emergency & common areas. Under such a situation, hot water will be provided to the guest in a bucket, or the guests may have to work with Candle Light. Request you to bear with such a situation kindly. We strongly regret such inconvenience.
- ❖ We reserve the right to re-arrange the itinerary to suit hotel availability without changing the total number of days in each destination and compromising any services.





# IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT THE VEHICLES PROVIDED & THE GUIDES ALLOTTED:

- ❖ Vehicles in Nepal are not on a disposal basis. To make full use of the day and complete the itinerary within the scheduled time, the guests must follow the timings given by our guide and driver.
- Chitwan being a jungle, hotels, lodges, and resorts provide vehicles for transfers and jungle activities. These vehicles may be of different categories from what has been provided in the voucher and other places. They may also not have air condition facilities.
- Our standard packages for Nepal do not include a guide. If the guests want a guide, a specific request has to be made via email. For such guides, extra supplemental charges will be applicable.
- ❖ In case of operational or mechanical problems, we reserve the right to change the vehicle between tours.
- ❖ In case any sightseeing is closed on any particular day, we shall make arrangements to provide alternate sightseeing on the same day.
- It is requested that the guests are soft and gentle with the drivers. The drivers are from remote places, and some do not know how to speak as they are not educated in tourism etiquette.
- Cancellation Since the Vehicles are limited in number, cancellation rules will be applicable on the complete tour package, including the transport cost.
- Generally, in Nepal, because of its location & Altitude, AC is not required; hence for the vehicles, we write NAC. If the guests insist on AC, Supplement cost per vehicle selection will be applicable. The AC will be on when the vehicle is on the move only. In case of uphill drive, AC shall be switched off.
- ❖ In Pokhara, the vehicles from Kathmandu are not allowed to do the sightseeing due to Transportation Union. Hence a local vehicle will be provided for the same.
- As the vehicles may change, please ensure that you do not leave your belongings in the vehicle as there is minimal possibility of getting them back. "We in no way will be responsible for the act."
- Please do note that cars in Nepal do not have carriers. When the guests have opted for vehicles like Car (Ford / Fiat / Manza / Swift Dzire / Similar) or Scorpio / Similar, please inform the guest to travel light with minimum baggage. For instance, the dicky of the cars can accommodate two large suitcases, and one or two small handbags can fit. In case of excess baggage, the guest will have to opt for an extra vehicle for carrying the excess baggage. The guest will directly pay the cost for this on the spot.
- Suppose the guests opt for a higher category vehicle instead of what is allotted. A higher category vehicle shall be provided at extra costs, which will be recovered on the sport. For instance, guests have been allotted Swift Dezire, and they later request Scorpio. In such a case, the guests have to pay supplemental charges on the spot.
- ❖ If the guests opt for any additional sightseeing not mentioned in the itinerary, additional charges shall be recovered on the spot.
- The vehicles provided by us in Nepal are not meant for self-drive. Only drivers can drive the vehicles.





# **Other Travel Information**

- 1. **Cancellation Policy** Read the cancellation policy of the hotels as well as of the tour operator.
- 2. **Clothes -** Remember to carry clothing as per the season and temperature in Nepal during travel. Also, remember to carry hiking shoes.
- 3. **Currency** Indian travelers can carry Indian Currency in INR 100 denominations or smaller notes into Nepal. Denominations of Rs 500 and above are legally banned in Nepal. Please note that 1 Indian Rupee = 1.6 Nepalese Rupee. Indian Rupee is widely accepted in Nepal.
- 4. **Documents -** All guests must carry original valid identity proof. Adults must carry an original & valid Passport or original Voter ID card. Children must carry an original & valid Passport or original birth certificate & school photo ID card. It is seen that guests very often, instead of carrying original documents, either carry the scanned copy of the document or a photocopy of the original. Please remember that Nepal is a foreign country. Anyone not carrying an original valid passport or voter I card shall be deported back by the immigrants and not allowed to enter the country.
- 5. **Electrical Plugs -** All major towns are well connected with electricity that runs on 220/240 volts with round hole two-pin and three-pin power outlets. You should bring flat-to-round pin converters for your electronics if necessary. However, most hotels offer multi-plug sockets.
- 6. Landslides Landslides are a common occurrence in hilly areas. Any expenses incurred for the modification in the tour shall be directly collected from the guest as per actual expenses.
- 7. **Personal belongings** Nepal is a very safe place. Your belongings are safe in the hotel/car, but on a BAD day, anything could go wrong, so we always suggest you carry your camera, wallet, passport, and valuable goods with you all the time
- 8. **Telephone Connections** International Roaming in Nepal is expensive. Please check with your mobile service provider for charges related to Nepal. If you need it, it's best to use a local sim. Tourists can quickly get the tourists sim in Nepal. To get the connection, they must submit a copy of the voter I card or the passport together with two passport-sized photographs to the vendor.
- 9. **Timing Difference -** Nepal is 15 minutes ahead of Indian Standard Time.
- 10. Twin Bedded Rooms Most of the hotels in Nepal have twin beds. We will try to give King/Queen beds in case of availability. If we cannot provide King/Queen beds, the guests will only have to stay in twin rooms.
